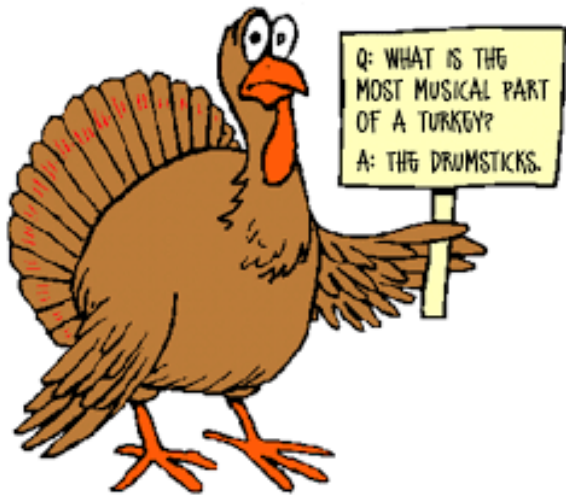
Smile for the camera! Oct 24th!
